MP208 pen



Needed:

Mandrel A; drill "V"; bushing 69A

Preparing the blank

- Cut the blank approximately ¼" longer than the length of the brass tube.
- Drill the blank through the centre, lengthwise, with the "V" drill bit.
- Polish the brass tube with sandpaper to clean off the oxidation and give the glue a better adhesion surface.
- 4. Plug the ends of the tube with a material of your choice we recommend base plate wax– to keep the glue from getting into the tube. Glue inside the tubes is a common cause of kit failure.
- Roll the tube in the glue. Insert the tube with a twisting motion until it is equidistant between both ends of the blank.
- **6.** Set aside until the glue has had time to reach its maximum strength.
- When the glue has cured, use a hobby knife to remove the plugs from the ends. Using a barrel trimmer of the proper size, square off the ends of the blanks until you can see bright brass tube. STOP at



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this point. This can also be done with the proper jig and a disk sander. *Not having the proper tube length is another common cause of pen failure.*

Turning the blank



- Assemble the blank on the mandrel using the 69A bushings, following the diagram above.
- 2. Bring the tail stock up and secure. Lightly tighten the mandrel and secure.
- **3.** Turn the pen blank to the desired shape using the bushings as a sizing guide.
- **4.** Sand the surface in progressive steps until you get to 400 or 600 grit. For a smooth finish, sand with Micro Mesh to 12,000 grit. Use a finish of your choice.
- **5.** Remove the blank from the mandrel.

Assembling the pen

- Press the center band into one end of the cap tube.
- **2.** Slide the clip onto the finial cap. Press the assembly into the clip bushing.
- **3.** Press the completed assembly into the other end of the cap tube.
- 4. Lay the cap aside.
- 5. Press the threaded nib coupler into one end of the blank.
- **6.** Press the threaded body coupler into the other end of the blank.
- **7.** Press the finial into the finial insert.
- **8.** Thread the finial assembly into one end of the threaded coupler.
- **9.** Place the spring on the end of the refill and slide the refill into the end of the pen.
- **10.**Thread the nib into the other threaded coupler.



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
