FOCUS

WHETHER YOU'RE USING A
CAMERA OR A PHONE TO
TAKE YOUR PHOTOS, YOU

NAIL THE FOCUS.

TIP:

TAKE MULTIPLE SHOTS OF
THE SAME THING SO YOU
CAN CHOOSE THE PHOTO
WITH THE SHARPEST IMAGE



BACKGROUNDS

TRY TO KEEP THE
BACKGROUND FREE OF
CLUTTER THAT MIGHT
DISTRACT FROM YOUR
ITEM.

TIP:

CRAFT PAPER MAKES FOR A
VISUALLY INTERESTING AND
INEXPENSIVE BACKGROUND. YOU
CAN FIND IT IN A WIDE VARIETY
OF COLOURS AND TEXTURES AT
YOUR LOCAL ART SUPPLY STORE!



LIGHTING

GOOD LIGHTING IS THE KEY TO
DISPLAYING YOUR WORK IN A
WAY THAT ACCURATELY
REPRESENTS COLOUR AND
TEXTURE



USE NATURAL LIGHT

TAKE PHOTOS IN NATURAL
DAYLIGHT. YOU CAN SET UP
NEXT TO A WINDOW, OR EVEN
OUTSIDE.



THE STICKY TACK TRICK!

STICKY TACK (ADHESIVE
PUTTY) IS A LIFE SAVER
WHEN IT COMES TO
PHOTOGRAPHING ROLLY
POLLY OBJECTS LIKE PENS!

IT ALSO WORKS WELL FOR
DISPLAYING THE PEN CAP
SEPARATELY.

TIP:

CHECK TO MAKE SURE THE
STICKY TACK ISN'T VISIBLE IN
YOUR PHOTO!



VARIATIONS

YOUR WORK BY TAKING
MULTIPLE PHOTOS WITH THE
PRODUCT DISPLAYED IN
